The 1967 "Swissvalian" Staff affectionately dedicates this book to Miss Elizabeth M. Jacobs and gratefully acknowledges her faithful services as teacher and friend. As sponsor of the "Swissvalian" for twentythree years, Miss Jacobs counseled wisely and guided well. This was the last of her many activities to go and her favorite one because in it she was able "to develop real friendships with such nice people." As her classes in Biology increased she became a full time teacher and it became necessary for her to drop one activity after another.

Early in her career at Swissvale High School, Miss Jacobs taught no classes, but sponsored the "Valistic." At that time, the work of cutting stencils and mimeographing was done by students. The paper came out regularly every two weeks in spite of power failures and other problems. Miss Jacobs was also in charge of Quill and Scroll and weekly Assembly Programs, which often featured student Variety Shows and one-act plays. The refreshment stand at the football games was another of her activities. Last, but not least, Miss Jacobs served as treasurer of The Activities Fund, a post still held.
