Swissvale High School has made a major change in the structure of their mini-courses. Instead of six, six weeks courses as before, they have changed to four nine week courses. The faculty has agreed that this will be better for everyone. It will give students a chance to learn more in each of the mini-courses and more time to bring up grades if students need the time. The only disadvantage would be that over the three years of high school students will only have twelve different courses of study instead of eighteen.



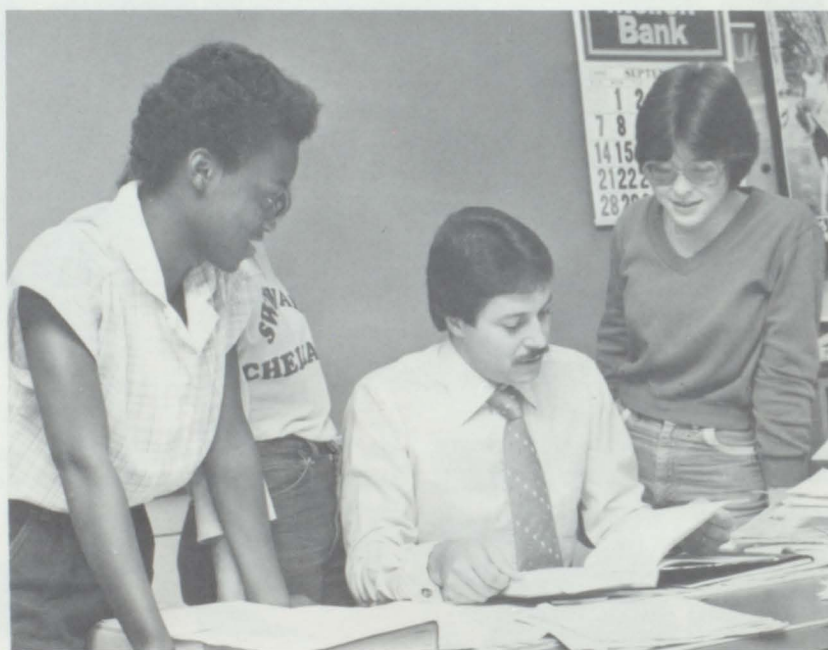

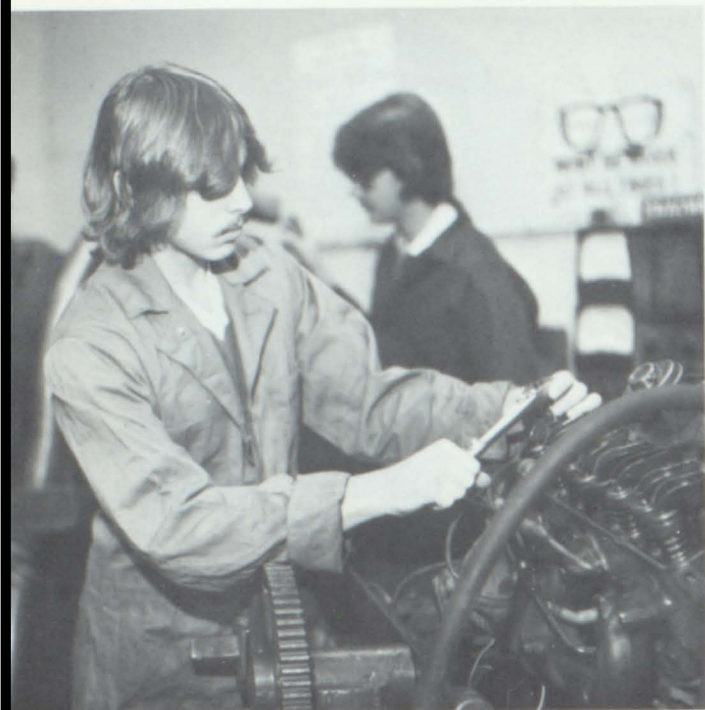

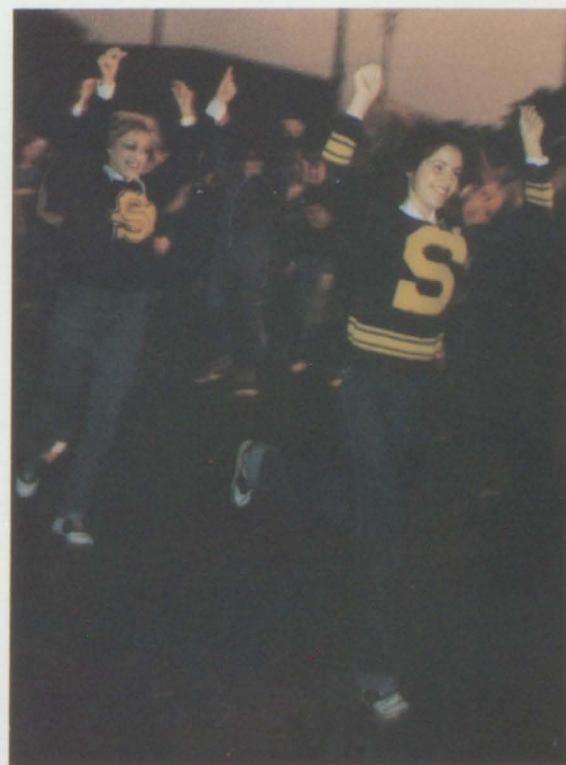

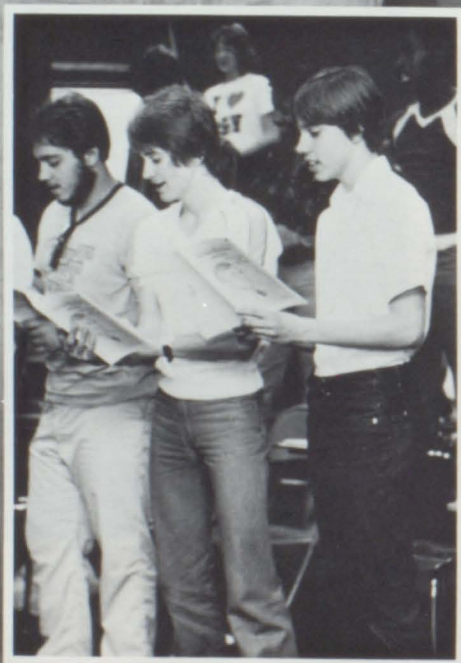

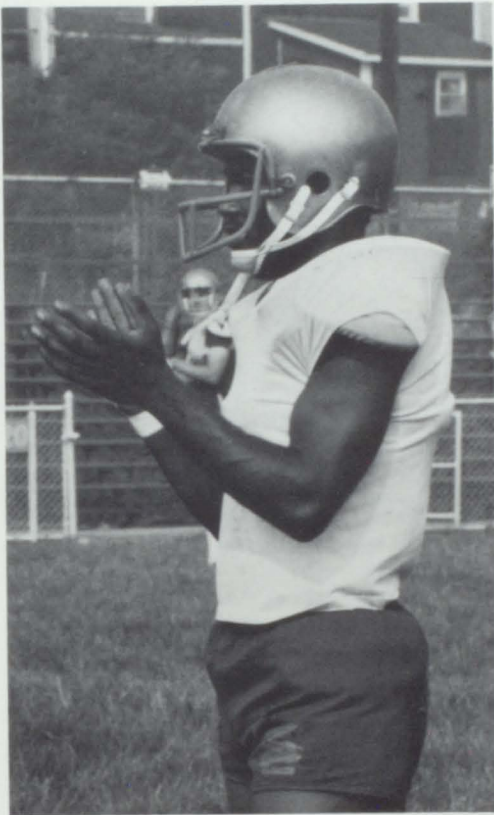

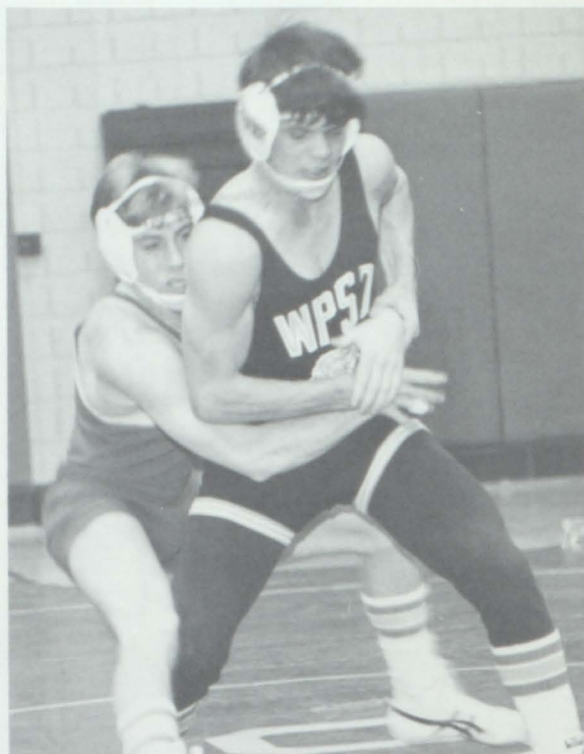

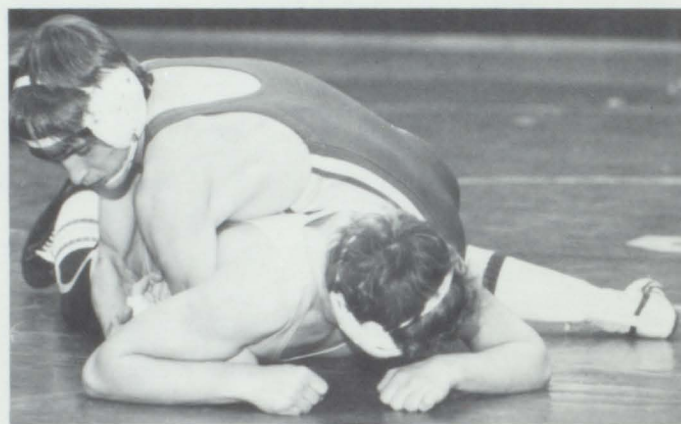

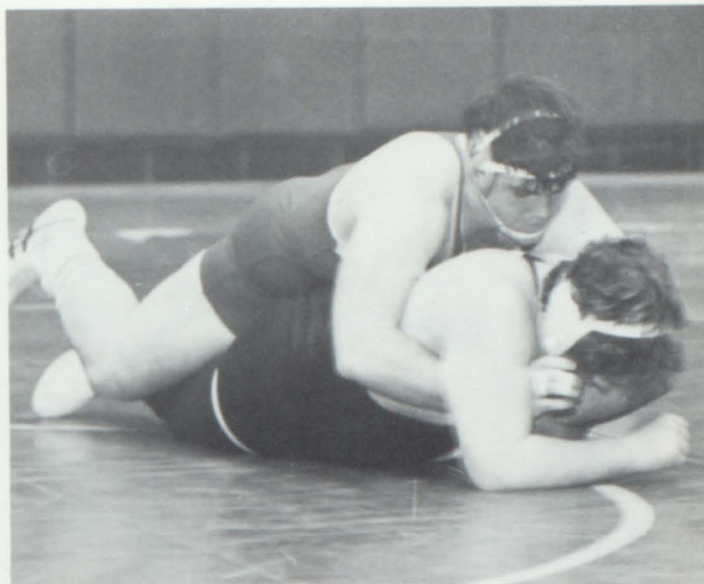

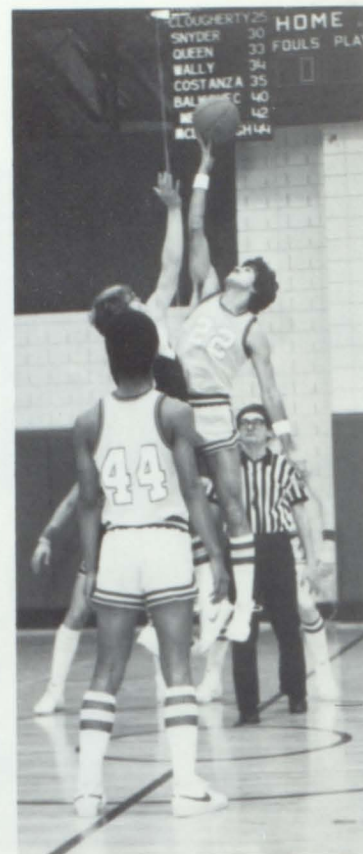

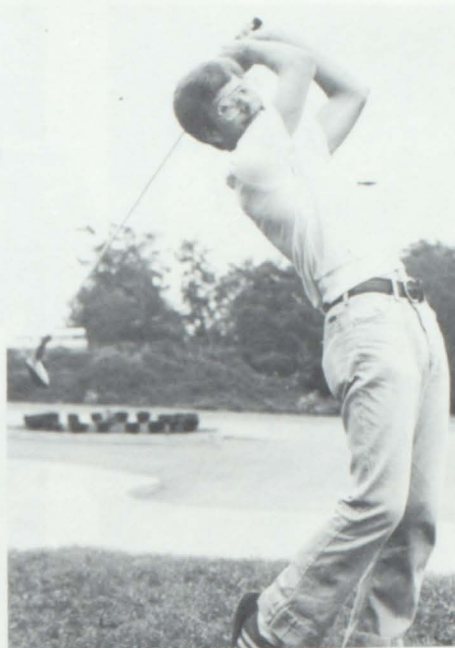
