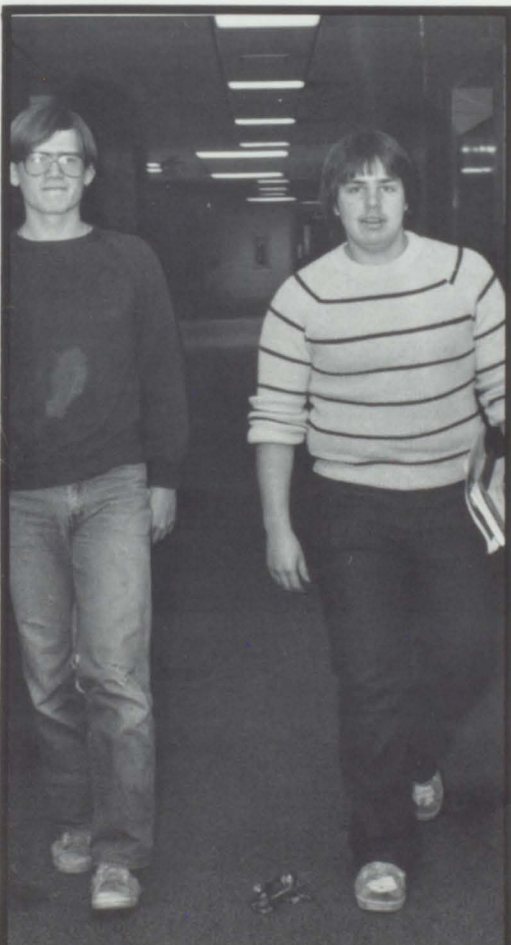

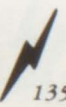
ranked Peters Township.
